Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you to those parents who joined us for our Eid assembly a few weeks ago; the children spoke clearly and they were very proud to share their stories and knowledge. As we move through the term, we will look for further assemblies to invite you to.

As part of the Academy due diligence process, last week we welcomed a visitor who carried out a Safeguarding audit. Throughout the day, she carried out various observations and spoke with pupils and staff. The pupils spoke confidently to her and expressed they feel safe in school and she concluded by confirming we have strong safeguarding procedures and culture within the school. As well as this, we had a visitor who was reviewing the teaching and learning within the school. Again, she was pleased with her observations, and the pupils she spoke with, were proud to showcase their work and confidently talked about their learning.

Please remember, we are a healthy school so be mindful of suitable snacks for students. For morning snacks, we encourage fruit or vegetables and please avoid other options.

4th July - Sports Day



Swimming - Drowning Prevention Week

The Royal Life Saving Society's (RLSS)

campaign is designed to proactively raise awareness of water safety ahead of a summer outdoors. Starting in May, through the summer, the risk to the public through accidental drowning increases significantly, DPW is critical in raising awareness and encouraging the public to enjoy water safely.

There was a 46% increase in the number of accidental fatalities amongst children, 35 accidental child fatalities were reported - the equivalent of a classroom of children. Every young person should have access to water safety skills that can be used throughout their life, no matter their background.

Hot Lunches



Money Raised - PTFA


Thank you for supporting Friends of HPS PTFA. These are the donations to school we made this Spring Term with funds raised:




THIS YEAR'S THEME AND ACTIVITY



Until...

Chickenpox	at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blisters have crusted over	
Diarrhoea and Vomiting	48 hours after their last episode	
Cold and Flu-like illness (including COVID-19)	they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow the national guidance if they've tested positive for COVID-19.	
Impetigo	their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics	
Measles	4 days after the rash first appeared	
Mumps 5 days after the swelling started		
Scabies they've had their first treatment		
Scarlet Fever	24 hours after they started taking antibiotics	
Whooping Cough	48 hours after they started taking antibiotics
