Dear Parents / Carers,

Welcome back to the start of the start of term. Thank you again to Friends of Hughenden Primary School for arranging the Halloween Trail – we look forward to hearing how much the event raised for the school. The Christmas Winter Wonderland event is set to be another fantastic afternoon – save the date for Friday 20th December from 1:30pm. There will be a raffle event on the day – if you are able to donate a raffle prize, or know of any local companies who would, please get in touch with either ourselves or FPTA.

Happy Diwali to those families who celebrated over the half term break. Each year group will be marking the importance of Diwali this week and we are inviting the children to wear bright and colourful clothes on Friday 8th November. We kindly ask for sensible shoes, and if you have PE on Friday afternoon, pupils are to bring their PE kit into school.

Since the start of term, we have welcomed 8 new families across the school to the Hughenden community. All 14 new pupils have settled in wonderfully and thank you to everyone who has made them feel welcome – it truly showcases our CHEER Values and the importance of a strong community. On Wednesday 13th November, we are hosting our second Open Morning for prospective parents. If you know of any families looking for a school place for their son or daughter, then please ask them to contact the school office to secure their place.

As a school, we continue to promote the importance of Reading, not only within the daily phonic and English lessons but across all areas of the curriculum. Foundation, Year 1 and Year 2 have been continuing with their Read Write Inc. phonic lessons, and across Key Stage 2, the pupils are continuing to enjoy their class books and their individual Accelerated Reader (AR) journey. As part of AR, we are able to see how many words the pupils have read this year – so far across all four-year groups, there has been nearly 4 million words read! This is an amazing achievement – let's see how many can be read by December!

Some staff changes have taken place since the start of the Autumn term. We have welcomed Ms. Myatt who is working in the school office and the lunch hall and Miss Anson as a full time LSA. Mrs Catlin has more recently joined the staff team as a full time LSA; she has transferred from another school within the Academy and we look forward to working with her. With sad news, unfortunately, Miss Warren has made the decision to step away from her role; this wasn't an easy decision for her and as a school, we wish her well. By the end of this week, I will be writing to Year 5 and Year 2 parents with regards to the teacher updates – these letters will be sent via e-schools.

Attendance at school is so, so important and it is everyone's responsibility. Good attendance helps with not only academic achievement but also social skills, routines and enhance learning opportunities. As parents, we ask you to:

- Ensure your child attends every day the school is open except when a statutory reason applies.
- Notify the school as soon as possible when their child has to be unexpectedly absent (e.g. sickness) before 9am.
- Only request leave of absence in exceptional circumstances and do so in advance.
- Book any medical appointments around the school day where possible.

The expected level of attendance is 97%. This equates to your child attending school for a minimum of 186 days across the whole school year. From last half term monitoring, if your child's attendance is significantly below this percentage, we will be writing to you separately. We want to continue to work with you to ensure that every child is able to attend school as frequently as possible.
