Coronavirus Update

The children have been talking about the Coronavirus, however, sometimes incorporated into a game which can upset people because obviously they are unaware of the possible seriousness of the virus. We have reminded all children in school on the importance of good hygiene and we've also covered this in assembly this week. You can help by doing the following:

- Encourage regular handwashing for at least 20 seconds by singing the Handwashing song whilst washing your hands ensures they'll be squeaky clean! Wash your hands after sport activities, using the toilet, on arrival at any childcare or educational setting and before cooking & eating.
- Try not to touch your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands Do not share items that come into contact with your mouth such as cups & bottles If unwell do not share items
- Bin it. If you need to cough or sneeze, you should wash hands with soap & water or hand sanitiser Kill it by washing your hands with soap & water or hand sanitiser
- Please advise us if you are aware of any links with positive diagnosis's so we can put plans in place if necessary.

We continue to monitor government guidelines from Public Health England. <u>Please note all visitors to school</u> will be asked to wash their hands on arrival. To further support this, we will not be shaking hands with visitors.

Educational School Trips

This is a plea for help! A lot of work goes into organising educational school trips to extend children's learning and enrich their curriculum, however, we are often having to phone and email parents to chase outstanding consents and payments. It is stated as a voluntary contribution for the majority of our school trips, however, as stated on all letters, if insufficient funds are received it puts the trip in jeopardy as we don't have a budget to cover this. IMPORTANT: Travel Updates

Last week we were notified by a couple of parents who were witness to, what could have been a nasty accident, on the Valley Road, on our school crossing. Mr Antoine was stepping out into the road when a car failed to stop and drove straight past, narrowly missing him. Mr Antione does a fantastic job helping our families cross the road safely every day and dangerous acts like this shouldn't happen. Please be mindful of the crossing at peak times and ensure you stop immediately when the patroller steps into the road.

BCC are still trying to recruit additional crossing patrollers – please let us know if this is of interest to you.

Dropping Off/Picking Up arrangements

We would like to remind our parents of the dropping off arrangements for children in the mornings.

Children can arrive from 8.30am onwards when office staff have arrived and are able to supervise children prior to going into the classroom. If there are no staff on duty outside, KS1 parents must bring their children to the school reception door so we both have peace of mind they have arrived safely.

For KS2 children, especially in year 5 and 6, we would like to encourage independence and incorporate this into their transition for secondary school by letting them walk to school either from a local side road, home if appropriate using the crossing patrol or the Village Hall.

We have a walking crocodile every Tuesday and Friday from the Village Hall where staff are there from 8.30am to supervise children walking to school and this also helps ease congestion on the local roads immensely. There is a registration form for this should you be interested.
