#### Bumped Head Policy – update

Currently, we make a call home to parents for any child who has had a bump from the neck up however slight. This was trialled and welcomed by parents. The adverse effect of this though, we believe, is that some children intentionally have small bumps as they enjoy the attention they receive.

Unfortunately, this could take staff away from more serious incidents. Moving forward, staff and first aiders will assess all children who have a bumped head and administer the appropriate first aid and ensure the accident book is completed. Class teachers will be informed as well as Quackers club staff if children are not going straight home. Where head bumps are genuine we will continue to complete the head bump letter and make a call home.

#### PE Kits

We have had an increasing number of children who do not have a PE kit held in school. Please ensure that it is kept in school or brought back first thing Monday morning so that it doesn't affect their participation in PE lessons. This includes suitable footwear for indoors and outdoor sports and warm layers for these colder months.

#### **Snow Updates**

As in the past, we reiterate that you should only make the journey to school if you feel it is safe to do so. Please note that we cannot guarantee there will be a crossing patroller in place for days we open the school later.
