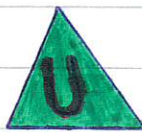

Age Ratings

Age ratings for films



= Suitable for all

U films should be suitable for audiences aged four years and over. If there is any violence, threat or horror in a U film, it should be over quickly.



= Parental guidance

Some parts may not be suitable for children. The film should be checked by parents. There may be some content such as language, violence etc.



= Cinema release - Suitable for 12 years and over

The 12A rating is only used for films shown in cinemas. These are suitable for children aged 12 and over. However, people younger than 12 may see a 12A, as long as they are with an adult.



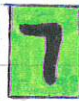
= Video release - Suitable for 12 years and over

The 12 rating is only found on videos and DVDs. No one younger than 12 may rent or buy a 12 rated video or DVD.

Age ratings for games



Games with a PEGI 3 rating is suitable for all age groups. These games should not contain any sounds or pictures that may frighten or upset young children.



PEGI 7 games are suitable for young children. These games with scenes or sounds may frighten younger children, because they have very mild forms of violence.



These games are suitable for children aged 12 and over. Games with a PEGI 12 rating video contains violence or sexual activity. This also includes bad language and probably gambling.



PEGI 16 games are suitable for ages 16 and over. This rating PEGI 16 rating video games contains violence or sexual activity. This also includes bad language, use of tobacco or illegal drugs can be used.



These are suitable for ages 18 and over. This rating PEGI 18 rating video games has extreme violence, killing, illegal drugs and sexual activity.

How to stay safe online?

Youtube

- Youtube is for people aged 13 or over.
- Youtube has a certain age group, which is 13+ because the children can watch any type of videos online, which are not relevant to them.
- Tell a trusted adult if there is a problem.

WhatsApp

- WhatsApp is for people aged 13 or over.
- Tell a trusted adult if you have a problem.
- The reason why you have to be aged 13 or over because there are some people, who try to bully and abuse you.
- Change your privacy settings to keep you safe. To do this go to your profile and select 'Account and Privacy'. Get the help from an adult if needed.

Last seen

- You can change this to 'My Contacts' to stop people to see if you are online or not.

Profile photo and info about you

- Put this to 'My Contacts' so, it will prevent people looking at your personal information.

Live Location

If you share your Location, turn this off here.

Roblox

- You have to be aged 13 or over to use Roblox.
- Tell a trusted adult if you have a problem.

Tik-Tok

- You have to be aged 13 or over to use Tik-Tok.
- This is because some people can comment on your videos and search for your account to know your personal information.

To be safe go to your profile, tap the three dots on the top right-hand corner and then select 'privacy and safety'.

- Tell a trusted adult if there is any problem.

Instagram

- You have to be aged 13 or over to use Instagram.
- To be safe, go to your profile and tap menu (3 horizontal lines), tap settings then scroll down Private Account and turn this on.
- You can still block and report anyone who's bullying you on this app.

Discord

- Need to be aged 13 or over to use Discord.
- Tell a trusted adult if there is a problem.
