

Weekly Home Learning

- Listen to your child read daily. Two books are sent home each week (to be returned weekly to school). Please aim to read the Phonics book 2-3 times and record this in their reading record. The other book is for pleasure and you can read it together with as much support as needed.
- Read to your child a range of text types, over a week, for 15 minutes every day.
- Support your children to complete One Minute Maths homework online.
- Encourage children to learn and use their weekly spellings.

Enrich Activities- Things you can do at home to Enrich your child's learning. This will help to empower your child in the classroom and help ignite their curiosity.

Year 2

Dear Parents, Carers and Children,

At Hughenden Primary School we follow the National Curriculum. This leaflet gives a brief outline of the knowledge and skills being learned in the curriculum in your class for this term.

English:

We will use the following as a stimulus for our descriptive story writing unit:

Jack and the Beanstalk

The children will focus on the following skills:

- **Descriptive story writing**
- **Spelling common exception words**
- **Handwriting**
- **Character description**

Maths:

The children will use White Rose Maths; a scheme that emphasises the development of problem-solving skills using concrete-pictorial-abstract approach. The children will focus on the following areas:

- **Place value**
- **Addition and subtraction**
- **Shape**

Science:

The children will focus on the following topics:

- **Animals and Humans**
- **Ask simple questions and devise ways to experiment and investigate**

In the rest of the curriculum we will be focussing on the following areas:

Outdoor learning:	The Art of nature
PE/Games:	Ball games and football (Monday)
Art and Design:	Drawing: Telling a Story
Music:	Exploring sounds through composing. Exploring pitch.
Geography	The UK: what kind of place is it?
Religious Studies:	Why do we give thanks?
PSHE:	Family and Friends
