NEW BOOKING SYSTEM

Just a reminder that our new booking system will go live from next week. Would all parents please register by visiting:

You will have flexible means of payment. You can either pay as you go, pay monthly or book several weeks in advance and pay in full. This will make things easier for both you and for us. We would encourage you to book in advance wherever possible, however if a child should show up to After School or Breakfast Club without prior booking, then there will be an extra fee of £5.00.

Please also note that we now require 2 weeks' notice of cancellations instead of 1 week and as before, there will be a late pick up fee of £5.00.

Should your child have any medical conditions or special dietary requirements, then you will be able to record this onto the booking system also.

We would kindly ask that parents settle all outstanding invoices as soon as possible, to allow us to move forward with our new system.

If you should have any questions, or difficulty with booking your child onto the system, then please of course, just let us know and we will be happy to help you.


WHAT WE HAVE BEEN UP TO

The children have been busy with their




creations during their time with us, and here are a few examples of some of the lovely work they have carried out....
