

## How to help at home

- Read with your child regularly.
- Take part in one-minute maths every week.
- Encourage children to use their phonics to sound out unfamiliar words & their memory for high frequency words
- Ask questions about what they have read to check their understanding, e.g. what do you think might happen next?
- Support your child with learning their weekly spellings using the 'Look, Cover, Write, Check' method
- Practice number bonds to 10 and 20
- Practise counting on from 10 and 20
- Practise counting to 100, crossing the 10s
- Practice counting in 2s, 10s and 5s
- Encourage activities that involve measures – length & weight

Curriculum Information – Spring Term 2025

Year 1

Dear Parents & Children,

This leaflet gives a brief outline of the knowledge and skills being learned in the curriculum in your class this term.

## English.

During our English Lessons, we will be focusing on:

- Writing for different purposes – fiction and non-fiction
- Use spoken language to develop understanding through imagining and exploring ideas.
- Develop a creative response to the text
- Performing poetry.
- Year 1 common exception words.
  
- Focusing on forming letters relative to their size.

## Maths

The children will focus on the following topics:

- Place value (Within 20)
- Addition and subtractions (within 20)
- Place value (within 50)
- Length and height
- Mass and Volume

## Science

The children will focus on the following topics:

- Identifying plants and their basic parts.
- Animals (Including humans).

In the rest of the curriculum we will be focussing on:

Computing	Online safety and why it is important to keep data safe.
PE	Master and apply basic movement skills; Participate in team games and improve co-ordination in outdoor games.
Music	Use bodies and instruments to listen and respond to pieces of classical music that represent animals. Also journey into the unknown and explore space through music, movement, chanting and the playing of tuned percussion instrument.
Geography	Continents and Oceans
RE	What do people believe God's job is? The importance of looking after the world
Design & Technology	Mechanisms: making a moving story book. Explore slider mechanisms and the movement they output. Design, make and evaluate a moving storybook from a range of templates.
PSHE	Understanding how we can look after ourselves inside and outside of school.
History	Traditional stories and what they can tell us about the past
Art	Painting and mixed media
