Dear Parents,

Welcome back to the new school year and all pupils (and staff!) have settled well after the winter holiday. We welcome back Mrs Messenger following her maternity leave and she has thoroughly enjoyed meeting her new class and getting to know them.

As we wrote to you in December, the school gate will be open from 8:40-8:50am so please ensure you arrive on time. We are mindful of unforeseen circumstances that can impact on the journey to school, such as the snow last week, and when these events happen, we alter the register times if needed. This will always be communicated via Class Dojo.

School Gate Times:

- **8:40am School Gate Opens** children to make their way into class to complete their morning activities
- 8:50am School Gate Closes registration will take place.
- Pupils arriving 8:55am to 9am will be recorded as late on the register
- After 9am Children arriving at this time will be recorded as late after the register closed and
 this is recorded as unauthorised absence unless a satisfactory explanation for the late arrival
 can be provided, for example, attendance at an exceptional medical appointment or
 notification that registers have been kept open for extreme conditions.

Heathy Drinks and Snacks

As a school we endeavour to promote a healthy mindset with regards to snacks and drinks consumed in school. Can we please ask, water bottles should only contain water and not juice or squash; under exceptional circumstances (medical/dietary requirements) different drinks can be considered but this needs to be discussed with either myself or Mrs Bendall alongside the class teacher. Key Stage 1 pupils are provided with a piece of fruit or vegetable to enjoy during their morning snack time. If you are choosing to send in an additional snack, this must be also be fruit or vegetables; crisps or packaged cheese and crackers are not suitable.

End of school day

Please be reminded that the school day ends at 3.10pm for KS1 (not including Hoppers), and 3.20pm for KS2. We have a small number who are consistently late and it is unfair on staff who sit there and wait. If you cannot collect at the relevant times without any reasonable explanation, children will need to be booked in to our wraparound care provider, Friends at Play, if they have the space available to do so.

NHS Pharmacy First Service

Did you know that the NHS Pharmacy First Service enables children and adults to get convenient access to healthcare advice and treatment where appropriate, for seven common conditions without the potential delay of having to wait for a GP appointment? Accessing the service may mean that we can help children feel better and get back to school as quickly as possible, as well as supporting parents/carers to also get better if they are unwell with one of the conditions covered under the service.

There is no need to make an appointment; parents or carers can pop into their local Boots pharmacy with their child and ask for help under the service.

Support for the following conditions can be accessed under the service, free of charge (unless NHS prescription charges apply):

Common condition	Patient eligibility
Earache	1 to 17 years
Impetigo	1 year and over
Infected insect bites and stings	1 year and over
Sore throats	5 years and over
Sinusitis	12 years and over
Uncomplicated urinary tract	Women 16 to 64 years
Shingles	18 years and over

<u>If you miss the cut-off, packed lunches will have to be provided for the whole week.</u>


