Foundation Class visit Pizza Express – Tuesday 12 July 2022

As part of our learning about where our food comes from, and ways that we can look after ourselves, Foundation Class have the opportunity to take part in some interactive workshops at Pizza Express in Marlow.

The workshops will involve trained chefs talking to the children about where the food comes from, how it is made, and each child will have the opportunity to make their own lunch. A full risk assessment will be completed to include children's allergies. This trip will provide the opportunity for children to develop their speaking and listening skills, mathematical skills and teamwork.

After we have made our pizzas we will walk down to Marlow Bridge and Higginson Park. This will give the children the chance to explore the local area before eating their pizzas. Your child will not need a packed lunch on this day. School will provide the fruit snacks.

We will be travelling in a coach fitted with 3-point seat belts. The coach will be leaving school promptly at 9.00am in order to arrive at the restaurant and settle the children in time for the start of their session at 9.30am. As such, we would ask that all children are in school at 8.45 am for registration and kitting out in hi-vis jackets. We aim to be arriving back at school at approximately 1.30 pm.

The visit to Pizza Express is free of charge but we would be grateful if you could send in a voluntary contribution of **£10** towards the cost of coach transport there and back. We are using some of our PTA class money to subsidise the coach cost, but if we do not receive sufficient contributions, the trip may not be able to go ahead.

Please return the attached Parental Consent Form and your contribution to the school office by **Friday 1 July**. Contributions and consent can now be made online using ParentPay (a separate letter giving instructions on how to set up your ParentPay account is being sent home with the trip letter), as well as by cash or cheque (made payable to Hughenden Primary School). If paying by ParentPay, parental consent can be given online and there is no need to fill in the attached Parental Consent Form.
