Dear Parents

Year 5 Woodrow High House Trip, 28 February to 1 March 2024

We are planning to take the Year 5 children away for an exciting two-night residential trip to Woodrow High House from Wednesday 28 February until Friday 1 March. The children have missed out on many trips and experiences in earlier years due to the pandemic, so this will be an amazing opportunity for them.

Woodrow underwent a full refurbishment a couple of years ago, so the children will benefit from the refurbished bedrooms, bathrooms and common areas. The cost of the two-night stay is £172 per child which includes accommodation (with bedlinen); all meals freshly prepared on-site, from dinner on the day of arrival to lunch on the day of departure (a packed lunch will be needed for the first day); nine daytime activities, an evening activity as well as their own personal lounge area and access to the games room, sports hall, swimming pool and 3G Astroturf pitch.

As Woodrow High House is just under 6 miles away, just off the A404 to Amersham and to keep the cost as low as possible, we are requesting that parents drop off their children between 9.00 and 9.15 am on Wednesday 28 February and collect them at approximately 3 pm (exact time to be confirmed) on Friday 1 March. We will be sending out a kit list nearer to the time of the trip.

In order to secure our booking with Woodrow and to meet their payment deadlines, we require a **deposit of** £50 per child by Friday 13 October 2023. Payment can be made by ParentPay or alternatively by cash/cheque (made payable to Hughenden Primary School). The balance of £122 will need to be paid by Monday 8 January 2024.

If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium or if the amount poses difficulties for you, please come and discuss this with us in confidence, as we really would like all the children in Year 5 to benefit from this exciting opportunity.

We will send out more information in early January with details of the arrangements, the programme and a kit list. Please note that mobile phones will **not** be permitted. Staff will be in contact with school, so essential messages can be passed to them.

Please complete the attached parental consent form and return to the school office with your deposit or fill in the consent boxes and pay online via ParentPay.
