GDPR New Processes

New Annual Consent Form

In order for us to be GDPR compliant, we ask that all parents complete the new annual consent form that went out in children's book bags yesterday and was also emailed out to parents. Could all parents please return this to the school office by the 4th of June.

Newsletters

After 25th May we will no longer be allowed to email newsletters out to parents. Instead we will be signposting to where you can read it on our school website.

Clubs and Hot Lunches

As you will be aware from the letters we have sent out, there are some essential changes coming into effect after May half term with regards to club bookings and paying for hot lunches for your children. With GDPR coming into force on the 25th May 2018, it is necessary to impose some changes that will alter the way parents pay for external services. Up to now, we have been able to accept cash or cheque payments from parents in the school office but from the 25th May 2018 this is no longer permitted. This is to enable us to be compliant with the new data protection laws.

All booking forms and payments for clubs will have to either be posted to the club direct, handed directly to the person running the club or via an online booking system and BACS/online banking payment. Some of our clubs already use an online method. Please note this may differ depending on the club. Full details will appear on their next club letter giving you details of how to book and pay. We will continue to post our Clubs Timetable on the school website under 'Clubs' to enable you to print booking forms at home and we are happy to continue providing copies of any club letter upon request, but all completed booking forms and payments must be posted directly to the club you are booking with.

All payments for Dolce must now be made either by setting up a Direct Debit or by calling Dolce Customer Services and making an online payment by debit card. The number to call is 01937 581427. Please note that you have a responsibility to ensure there are sufficient funds on your child's account to cover the cost of any lunch taken. The best way to avoid going into deficit is to set up a Direct Debit. You can access the Direct Debit form by logging into your Live Kitchen account. This is the easiest way to manage payments. Please contact us if you need a reminder of your login details.

School Reports

Children's end of year school reports will be sent home on Wednesday the 11th of July. You will have the opportunity to raise any general queries at our Open Day.

Open Day

We will be holding an Open Day on Monday the 16th of July. The first time slot for this will be from 2:30 to 3:15 and the second will be from 3:45 to 4:30. Teachers will not be available to talk to between 3:15 to 3:45 as they will be seeing the children out safely. Parents are welcome to visit and look around the school, visit new teachers and visit new classrooms and talk to staff. Please note if you need a separate appointment please contact the school office to arrange.

Lost Property

Please could all parents check lost property before the end of term as we will be donating any unclaimed and unnamed items to charity.

Forgotten Eschools Passwords

If you have forgotten your log in details for Eschools and you have provided the school with an email address for yourself, you can use the forgotten password function rather than contacting the office for a new password. This also enables you to be able to use your email address in place of your username.

If you contact Eschools directly, they will be unable to provide you with a new password as they can't be certain of your identity over the phone.

If you have any questions or are having difficulty resetting your password, please do not hesitate to contact the school office.
