Drowning Prevention Week - 15th - 22nd June 2024

With the Summer term coming up and family's going on holidays, taking a moment to read through the safety guideline to staying safe around water could help save a life. The RNLI hold Drowning Prevention Week 15th – 22nd June. The RLSS has a proud history of helping to reducing the number of lives lost to drowning. Anywhere there is water, there is a risk of drowning especial for children.

Whenever you are around water:

STOP AND THINK

Take time to assess your surroundings. Look for the dangers and always research local signs and advice.

STAY TOGETHER

When around water always go with friends or family. Swim at a lifeguarded venue.

In an emergency:

CALL 999

Ask for the Fire and Rescue Service when inland and the Coastguard if at the coast. Don't enter the water to rescue.

FLOAT

Fall in or become tired - stay calm, float on your back and call for help. Throw something that floats to somebody that has fallen in.

- Take time to **review safety notices**
- Always **look out for potential hazards**.
- **Never use inflatables in open water** – although they look fun, inflatable water toys can quickly get caught in the wind and be blown out to sea.
- Be sure **everyone in your group knows who to call** in an emergency. If you are abroad, be sure you know the correct number to call.
- Make sure the **whole family knows basic water safety** and what to do if they find themselves in the water unexpectedly.




STEP 3 - FILL IN THE FORM

Yes

Until...

Chickenpox

at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blisters have crusted over

Diarrhoea and Vomiting

48 hours after their last episode

Cold and Flu-like illness
(including COVID-19)

they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow the national guidance if they've tested positive for COVID-19.

Impetigo

their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics

Measles

4 days after the rash first appeared

Mumps

5 days after the swelling started

Scabies

they've had their first treatment

Scarlet Fever

24 hours after they started taking antibiotics

Whooping Cough

48 hours after they started taking antibiotics
