Year 3 (Currently Year 2) Swimming Lessons

Year 3 will have weekly swimming lessons at Wycombe Leisure Centre. Lessons will take place each Wednesday afternoon and will start on Wednesday 20 September 2023. The last session for the term will be on Wednesday 6 December 2023, eleven sessions altogether. Tuition will be provided by the Centre's swimming instructors and trained school staff.

Swimming and water safety is a statutory element of the physical education national curriculum and all primary schools must provide swimming and water safety lessons so that children have the skills to keep themselves safe while enjoying swimming with friends and family.

Children will need to bring:

- Towels and swim suits (one piece for the girls and close-fitting trunks for the boys – no Bermudas!)
- Goggles may be worn but will need to be removed for specific activities.
- All pupils **must** wear a swimming hat.
- No jewellery – earrings must be removed or if this is not possible, covered with Elastoplast.

We are travelling to Wycombe Leisure Centre by a coach fitted with 3-point seat belts. The use of the pool, tuition costs and part of the coach cost will be covered by the school but we are requesting a contribution of £45.00 towards the cost of the transport for the eleven sessions during the Autumn Term.

Please return your Parental Consent Form and contribution by the start of next term. Consent can be given online via ParentPay or by returning the paper parental consent form. Contributions can be made using ParentPay, or by cash/cheque made out to Hughenden Primary School. If you have any questions, please contact the school office where someone will be happy to help.
