


Written Statement of Behaviour Principles

Written Statement of Behaviour principles

This statement has been developed with the intention of securing the best learning and working environment for staff and pupils.

- 1. The school's behaviour policy is understood by pupils, staff, parents and governors.
- 2. The behaviour policy makes clear the school's expectations, rules and routines, enabling children to understand what is expected of them and thus be ready for learning.
- 3. Every pupil understands they have the right to feel safe, valued and respected, and to be able to learn, free from the disruption of others.
- 4. All pupils, staff, parents, governors and visitors are free from any form of discrimination.
- 5. Pupils are helped to take responsibility for their actions and the choices they make.
- 6. Staff and volunteers set an excellent example to pupils at all times.
- 7. Rewards, sanctions and de-escalation strategies are used consistently, by all staff; in line with the behaviour policy.
- 8. Families are involved in behaviour incidents, in order to foster and support good relationships between the school and pupils' home life.
- 9. The school's exclusions policy explains that exclusions will only be used as a last resort, and outlines the processes involved in suspensions and exclusions.
- 10. The governing board also emphasises that violence or threatening behaviour will not be tolerated in any circumstances.

This written statement of behaviour principles is reviewed and approved by the Full Governing Board in-line with the school policy schedule.
