Swimming – Drowning Prevention Week

The Royal Life Saving Society's (RLSS) campaign is designed to proactively raise awareness of water safety ahead of a summer outdoors. Starting in May, through the summer, the risk to the public through accidental drowning increases significantly, DPW is critical in raising awareness and encouraging the public to enjoy water safely.

There was a 46% increase in the number of accidental fatalities amongst children, 35 accidental child fatalities were reported - the equivalent of a classroom of children. Every young person should have access to water safety skills that can be used throughout their life, no matter their background.
