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All parents and members of the school community are encouraged to get involved, even if they only have a small amount of time available. All families are automatically members of the 'Friends of Hughenden Primary School' PTFA when their child joins our school.

The PTFA is extremely conscious of the ethos and diversity of our school, and we try very hard when organising and planning events to respect this. Not all of our events are run as fundraisers. We fund fun events for our children's enjoyment such as the Christmas party, when we fund a professional entertainer and token gifts for each child.

How can you get involved?

Many hands make light work, and the more support and volunteers we have the better! The board ensures the day to day running of Friends PTFA Committee but can't run it alone! We rely heavily on our Class Reps and Volunteers.

Our Annual General Meeting (AGM) is held at the beginning of the academic year and provides an opportunity for all parents to come along and hear in more detail about the work of the PTFA, the events we have run, the funds we have raised and how the money has been spent. It is also the occasion when we elect our new committee members and class representatives.

Our class representatives undertake a very important role. Class representatives provide a link between individual class parents and the PTFA committee. The support from class representatives is vital when it comes to organising our main events from selling tickets to organising rotas of help.

How we spend the money we raise

PTFA funds are not generally spent on improving the fabric of the school building as this is the responsibility of the school Governing Body. Our Constitution commits the PTFA to spending money on things that will benefit students directly. In 2021-22 we donated £1,500 to enable school purchase the RWI Phonics reading scheme books to support the curriculum.

How can you keep up to date with our events and activities?

- 1) We use Classlist to convey information to parents regarding our activities. Classlist is a virtual communication platform for the PTA to reach all the parents, organise events, fundraise and recruit volunteers. Classlist is unique to your school and only accessible to approved users. Parents can also use it to contact each other about play dates, parties and more. What's more, it's completely free to use and data protection registered with the ICO, so you can trust that your parent details are safe and never passed to third parties.
