Sports Day 2022 – Thursday 7th July

The children have all started practising their races and events for Sports Day, and you are invited to join us in cheering them all on. The children will be competing in their houses **Ash**, **Maple**, **Oak**, and **Chestnut**. (The colours highlighted are the house colours). If you are unsure of your child's house, please ask at the school office.

Weather dependant, Sports Day will be taking place on **Thursday 7th July**. If we are forced to cancel, we are planning to re-schedule for Tuesday 12th July. If there is excessive heat on the day, we will alter the schedule in order to keep everyone safe, but still go ahead.

Please ensure that your child comes to school wearing a top in their house colour if possible, and P.E. shorts. Dependant on weather, can you apply sun cream before school, bring a sun hat and plenty of water to drink during the day.

Schedule for the Day

Hoppers, Foundation and KS1 will be participating in their tasks and races in the morning starting at 10:00 to 11:30. The children will break for lunch when the races are finished. If time allows, we may have some parent and toddler races too!

There will be no hot lunches being served on Sports Day so all children will need to bring a packed lunch with them. If they normally have school lunch provided, they will be supplied with a packed lunch by our caterers, Dolce. You are welcome to bring your own lunch and join in for a picnic with your child if you would like to from 12 noon on the field.

At 1.00pm, Hoppers, EYFS and KS1 teachers will blow a whistle and those children should return to class. Shortly after KS2 will start their sports day. KS1 children may come out with their class teachers during the afternoon and cheer on KS2 children in their races. At the end of the afternoon, scores will be announced.

All children will be return to class to collect their belongings and be dismissed as usual by their class teachers at 3.10pm EYFS/KS1 and 3.20pm KS2.

Polite reminder: Friday 8th July is a school INSET day so children are NOT in school. Do enjoy the long weekend.
