Dear Parents

We are very excited to be able to plan to take the Year 5 children away for a two-night residential trip to Woodrow High House from Wednesday 9 February until Friday 11 February. Given the disruption to their recent schooling and the fact the children have missed out on many trips and experiences in Y3 and Y4 due to the pandemic, we believe this will be an amazing opportunity for them.

Woodrow is currently undergoing a full refurbishment so the children will be one of the first groups to benefit from the refurbished bedrooms, bathrooms and common areas. The cost of the two-night stay is £140 per child which includes accommodation (bedlinen included), all meals freshly prepared onsite, from dinner on the day of arrival to lunch on the day of departure (a packed lunch will be needed for the first day), nine day activities, an evening activity as well as their own personal lounge area and access to the games room, sports hall, swimming pool and 3G AstroTurf pitch.

As Woodrow High House is just under 6 miles away, just off the A404 to Amersham and to keep the cost as low as possible we are requesting that parents drop off their children between 9.00 and 9.15 am on Wednesday 9 February and collect them at the end of the day (exact time to be confirmed) on Friday 11 February. We will be sending out a kit list nearer to the time of the trip.

The cost of the two-night stay at Woodrow will be £140 per child. In order to secure our booking with Woodrow and meet their payment deadlines, we require a **deposit of £50 per child by 18 October 2021**. Payment can be made by ParentPay or alternatively by cash/cheque (made payable to Hughenden Primary School). The balance of £90 will need to be paid by 17 January 2022.

If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium or if the amount poses difficulties for you, please come and discuss this with us in confidence.

We will have a parent meeting in January (exact date to be confirmed) to go through the arrangements, the programme and a kit list. Please note that mobile phones will **not** be permitted and the children will not be contacting home. Staff will be in contact with school so essential messages can be passed to them.

Please complete the attached parental consent form and return to the school office with your deposit.
