How to help at home

- Read with your child a range of text types, over a week, for 15 minutes every day and record this in their reading record.
- Support your children to complete Mymaths homework online.
- Encourage children to learn and use their weekly spellings.
- Encourage your children to become responsible for completing their homework independently and in a timely manner.
- Remind your child to ask if they do not understand a word when they are reading and to practice reading aloud to you.
